



## CULTURAL HERITAGE SITES, MUSEUMS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

### RULES TO BE FOLLOWED AT THESE LOCATIONS

- Please keep your voice level low during your visit.
- Be respectful of other visitors and do not make noise.
- Ensure your children behave in a way that doesn't disturb the space.
- If taking photos or recording videos is prohibited, please respect those rules.
- Even in areas where photography is permitted, try to avoid using the flash, as some objects are sensitive to light.  
It may be sensitive.
- If there are areas in museums or archaeological sites that require special permits, please comply with those rules.
- Avoid direct contact with the artworks and structures. The areas your hands touch can deteriorate over time.  
This can lead to deterioration.
- In some museums, close examination of exhibits is not permitted; in such cases, pay attention to the directional signs.
- Enter through the designated entrance doors and follow the exit directions.
- When leaving, cease engaging with any artwork or objects and exit the area.
- Before entering a museum or archaeological site, have your bag, backpack, and large items checked by security.
- Food and beverage consumption is prohibited in some areas. Please bring your own food and drinks in advance.  
Prepare it.
- Keep the environment clean, don't leave trash around.
- Use the recycling bins located in the museum or archaeological site.
- Don't forget to pay the entrance fee before visiting.
- Make sure you don't lose your ticket, as it's usually only valid once purchased.
- If available, use a guide or audio guide.
- Carefully review educational materials, brochures, or audiovisual content.
- Do not go outside the permitted areas.
- Do not enter areas closed to visitors at archaeological sites or museums.
- Follow the marked paths for the safety of the area.
- In case of any emergency, contact the staff or security personnel.
- In museums, be careful not to damage items, especially valuable or fragile ones.
- Keep your belongings from scattering and handle your personal items carefully.
- Some artifacts or places in museums or historical sites may be emotionally sensitive. Others  
Respect their emotional boundaries.
- Visit during business hours and avoid areas close to closing times.  
Try not to separate.
